Q1: WHO can sign up?

A1: The alumni, who entered the NTU College in 1981 with the first two digits of student ID as 70, including those programs requiring more than 4-year study, or were graduated in 1985, including those with the first two digits less than 70. The NTU teachers, family and friends of those alumni are welcome. The registration of these guests is the same as the alumni. However, each alumnus is suggested to invite only one family or friend due to the space constraint. In addition, each department is suggested to invite your teachers to sit with you, and share the registration fee for the invited teachers as a student-group.

Q2: TO WHOM for me to register?

A2: The representative(s) of each department is in charge of the registration. You may find the list in our reunion website. Please inform your departmental representative the name list and pay the registration fee directly to him/her. The alumni and their guests are generally arranged to sit with their departmental classmates. For any exception, please inform your departmental representative about your seating preference, so that your representative can coordinate with the reunion committee. Please be noted that the reunion dinner will offer half vegetarian dishes, so that you do not need to specify your meal preference in registration.

Q3: WHEN is the due date for registration?

A3: The due date for the payment is 2015/4/30. If you cannot come to the reunion on 2015/6/13 after the due date of registration, the committee will not refund to the individual paid-alumnus. However, your departmental representative can coordinate any replacement and refund within the classmates and/or with other departments.

Q4: WHERE and WHEN is our reunion?

A4: The NTU 30th Reunion is held at 5PM, 2015/6/13 at the NTU Stadium. Because there are very few venues accommodating a banquet of 1300+ guests, and of course the NTU does charge our reunion for free. This is why the NTU 30th Reunion is held on the same day as the graduation ceremony every year.

Q5: HOW MUCH for me to register?

A5: NTD 2000 per person, including alumni, teachers, and guests; NTD 1000 per quest younger than 12 years old. The registration fee covers all the individual costs of meal and souvenir, as well as the collective costs of performance stage and photo taking. The reunion committee will raise fund if any shortage, or donate any surplus to NTU on behalf of the reunion alumni. Because the reunion is an informal volunteer organization, no invoice or receipt can be issued for the registration fee. Your understanding is much appreciated.
